Kids InfoBits is a highly visual and easy-to-use digital resource for K-5 students featuring age-appropriate, reliable, curriculum-related content covering a broad range of educational topics. This is a great supplemental resource for media specialists and teachers looking to introduce students to database searching or for children



1. To begin, go to **OhioWebLibrary.org**.
 2. Click on the arrow beside the phrase “**Homework Help**”:
 3. Click on the words. “**Kid InfoBits**”
- OR Type <http://ohioweblibrary.org/db/kidsinfobits> into your browser’s address bar.

To **Search** for content, click in the search box and type a term
To **Browse** for content, click on one of the images.
When browsing, clicking an image will display relevant **subtopics**.
Select the subtopic you wish to explore. This will lead to a list of **subjects**.

From the reading view, users have a number of options to make their experience more accessible.



The **Listen** button is a text-to-speech feature that allows students of any reading level to hear the article read aloud.

The **Tools Menu** on the right hand side allows users to create citations, highlight notes, save to cloud storage, print, send a copy of the article via email, download the article as a PDF, share the article via social media platforms or save the article to a **user folder**.

To access materials stored in a **user folder**, click the **More** button at the top right of the screen. This menu also includes educator resources, a help file, a dictionary and more.
